#### **Public Forum**

One Member of the Public asked if there were dates available for Defibrillator Training. BM advised that he was still trying to arrange a suitable date and time and would likely have to use a different First Responder service.

One Member of the Public reported that fencing was being removed at Pound Meadow following the public auction.

One Member of the Public thanked the Council for organising the meeting with the Environment Agency at Bisham Stream, and particularly to MRB and GW for attending.

One Member of the Public reported a build-up of debris alongside the Abbey Fence, and that the footpath near the school is impassable. BM gave an update on conversations with Abbey and School.

One Member of the Public asked if the Bridleway on the A404 would be extended into Bisham Village. JC reported that the Council was unaware of any plan for this.

One Member of the Public raised the idea of getting the roundabout sponsored to provide a more attractive gateway to the village.

One Member of the Public asked about the possibility of Electric Car Charging points in the village. JC said it is something the Council can consider going forward. BM gave an update on funding opportunities.

One Member of the Public raised a complaint about the Abbey fence ruining the view of the Abbey. AK mentioned that the Borough had promised to offer an explanation as to why the fence was permitted development.

One Member of the Public raised an issue with the maintenance of roads and footpaths, as the condition had deteriorated, and reported that there had been several accidents along the stretch of fence. Suggested that a one-way-system through Bisham would reduce issues. AK pointed out that this seemed to be a common problem in other villages in the Borough.
