- GW reported that he had chased Playsafety for an inspection date following the confusion about previous payments.
- JK reported that there was a plan to edit the oral history project into a more user-friendly format.

73. Highways

GW reported a change in profile on the surface of one of the speed bumps in Burchetts Green, possibly caused by subsidence.

GW noted an increase in cars parked on the pavement along Burchetts Green road, causing an obstruction. GW to raise with the Parking Office in October.

GW reported on the correspondence from a local resident asking RBWM to consider a 20mph restriction in Henley Road and was in the process of raising a petition.

JC proposed supporting, in principle, the reduction of the speed limit or introduction of traffic calming on Henley Road if the Highways Officers were satisfied with the impact. GW seconded

Cllrs agreed

BM to liaise with resident.

CL reported that permission had been granted for four fun-run events to proceed down Temple Lane, despite RBWM officers stating that the road was unsafe. BM to contact RBWM and ask why this had been allowed.

CL reported on a meeting regarding the A404 culvert works, stating that the responses from the designers had been inadequate. CL asked that BM write to National Highways and the Environment Agency for answers to the following questions:

JK asked if the footbridge height had been addressed. CL reported that the footbridge had been mentioned, but no plans discussed. BM to write to RBWM to raise the issue of the footbridge.

JC noted that Marlow Bridge needed significant structural repairs, but the work was being planned in a way that didn't require a complete closure. JC also reported that the issue of ANPR cameras were also being revisited.

74. Parish Land

GW proposed accepting the fence quote from Stuart Wilcox for £550.

CL seconded

Cllrs agreed

AK abstained from the vote.

BM to instruct the contractor

CL raised the issue of increased bin collections as the playground bin fills more quickly than the orchard. JK suggested moving one of the orchard bins to the playground. BM to get a price.

75. Tree Works

BM to arrange a meeting with M&J after 2nd October. JK has produced a tree plan of the orchard to help Cllrs to visualise the works.

CL reported that a tree in the Orchard had started to tilt, and asked that it be looked at.

JK asked that any tree chippings be spread along footpaths.

76. Playground

JC thanked JK for volunteering to clean the play equipment.

77. Flooding

CL stated that there had still been no report from RBWM regarding the flooding earlier in the year, and that the flood manager hadn't replied.

BM to write to the Flooding Officer to ask for the data asap.

78. Website

CL asked that the website be update to move items further forward, such as minutes and agendas. BM to trial a new format ahead of the next meeting to review.

79. Finance

BM gave an update on the finances.

BM gave an update on the proposed banking changes.

GW proposed switching to the Unity Trust account.

CL seconded

Cllrs agreed.

80. Correspondence

GW reported that a letter had been sent to Burchetts Green residents regarding the felling of cypress trees on the edge of BCA land. GW wants to check if they are within the conservation area.

81. Information Reports

JC reported on the Marlow Society meeting where the film studio application appeal was discussed. Also, Bucks Council have committed to building 10,000 homes over five years, and Marlow has been earmarked as a development area.
